

SEPULVEDA BASIN WILDLIFE CONSORTIUM

Minutes of the March 11, 1993 meeting:

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM and the minutes of the February meeting approved as corrected.

A discussion was held regarding the Chambers Group study of management alternatives for the wildlife reserve. All members were requested to submit comments.

A discussion was held regarding the April 25, 1993 Great L.A. Cleanup event in the Sepulveda Basin. A motion was made, seconded and passed (MSP) to combine the planting of cottonwoods along Haskell Creek north of the reserve and to authorize the spending of money as necessary to properly plant the area between the Reserve and the parking access road. Another motion was MSP to authorize spending up to \$250 to purchase signs to advertise this event. *the Great LA Cleanup*

A discussion was held regarding the Sepulveda Basin Urban Wildlife Refuge Workshop scheduled for June 5, 1993. A motion was MSP to authorize spending up to \$200 for publicity and expenses for this event.

Peter Ireland presented information on potential sources of grants. It was agreed that we should pursue other possible sources of funds. Bill Principe stated that he would review the material and follow up appropriately.

Rose Marie White presented an update on the Canadian Geese study.

Steve Hartman presented and distributed a variety of papers on riparian rerstoration and revegetation projects relevant to the Sepulveda Dam Basin.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:35 PM.
